Further Reflection for 10/17

Reflection:

- 1. What is a moment in which someone made room for you in a crowded group? What is a moment when someone did not make room for you and how did you feel?
- 2. What about the Bible is most difficult for you to understand? **Study:**
- 1. Read John 1:1-5, 9-14, 16-18
 - a. What jumps out to you?
 - b. Substitute "Jesus" in the spots in verse 1 for the words "the Word." How might you now understand this?
 - c. How might you understand verses 2-3?
 - d. Why might John use the picture of dark and light?
 - e. Why is it important for Paul (and u?)
- 2. Read John 14:9-11
 - a. How do we understand the relationship between Jesus and the Father from these verses?
- 3. Read Matthew 5:3-10
 - a. Which Beatitude makes the most sense to you?
 - b. Which Beatitude is one you struggle with?
- 4. Read Matthew 16:24-27; 22:37-40
 - a. How do we understand how we are called to live all of life based on these words?

Application:

- 1. What, based on today's texts, is the most life giving thing that is shared from the Scriptures?
- 2. What words from Jesus are hard for you to follow?
- 3. Write your own story: Who you were before Jesus. When you encountered Jesus Who you are in Jesus and who He is calling you to become

Prayer:

Father, help me to focus on Jesus. May my life be centered on who He is and who he calls me to be. In Jesus' name I Pray. Amen.

Spiritual Practice:

• Spend time reading and re-reading the Beatitudes. See if you can memorize them.
