John 1:14-18

¹⁴The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed His glory, the glory as the One and Only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. ¹⁵(John testified concerning Him and exclaimed, “This was the One of whom I said, “The One coming after me ranks ahead of me, because He existed before me.”) ¹⁶Indeed, we have all received grace upon grace from His fullness, ¹⁷for the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. ¹⁸No one has ever seen God. The One and Only Son, Who is Himself God and is at the Father’s side He has revealed Him.

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**1. HE BECAME A MAN TO SHOW US
WHAT GOD IS LIKE**

Hebrews 11:1-4... ¹ Long ago God spoke to the fathers by the prophets at different times and in different ways. ² In these last days, He has spoken to us by His Son. God has appointed Him heir of all things and made the universe[a] through Him. ³ The Son is the radiance of God’s glory and the exact expression of His nature, sustaining all things by His powerful word. After making purification for sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high. ⁴ So He became higher in rank than the angels, just as the name He inherited is superior to theirs.

Hebrews 4:14-16... ¹⁴ Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens—Jesus the Son of God—let us hold fast to the confession. ¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tested in every way as we are, yet without sin. ¹⁶ Therefore let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us at the proper time.
