JOHN 15:1-16 part 9

"FRUIT-BEARING"

John 15:7-8 MSG: "But if you make yourselves at home with Me and My Words are at home in you, you can be sure that whatever you ask will be listened to and acted upon. This is how My Father shows who He is—when you produce grapes, when you mature as My disciples."

John 15:7-8 TPT: "But if you live in LIFE-UNION with Me and if My Words live POWERFULLY within you—then you can ask whatever you desire and it will be done. When your lives bear (produce) abundantly fruit, you DEMONSTRATE that you are My mature disciples who glorify My Father!"

FRUIT BEARING:

1. There are the _____ branches, and the _____ and _____ are made to them. These are the same as the fruitful branches mentioned earlier. (John 15:2-3) Jesus had already covered the pruning or the disciplining of the branches, so here He covers the promises made to them and the results of their "_____ " in Him. Note that the promises and results are **CONDITIONAL** or **UNCONDITIONAL**: "*If you abide in Me...*" Note also that the Word of Christ must abide in the believer. The thought is that a believer must take the Words of Christ and...

- I. The attached branch receives _____, that is answered prayers.
 - a. The branch is attached _____ the VINE. The branch abides _____ the Vine: dwells and lives and never faces a moment when it is not attached to the Vine. So it is with the believer. The believer is attached _____ Christ, the true Vine: he abides, dwells, lives, and walks _____ the very presence of Christ, never facing a moment when other is not attached and walking in Christ. A genuine believer walks in _____ fellowship and prayer with the Lord. He is always abiding and _____ with the Lord.
 - b. Similarly, the Vine is always _____ the branch, always sending its LIFE-GIVING food and drink to the branch. So it is with Christ. Christ is ALWAYS share His LIFE-GIVING _____ with the believer, ALWAYS _____ prayer and _____ the needs of the genuine believer.

II. The attached branch _____ God by bearing MUCH fruit. Remember what the fruit is. It is...

- _____: "*Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God*". (Philippians 1:11)
- _____: "*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering (patience), gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, self-control: against such there is No Law.*" (Galatians 5:22-23)
- _____ "*If, my brothers and sisters, you did not already know, my plans were set to meet you in Rome, but time and circumstances have forced every trip to be cancelled until now. I have deeply desired to see you some good fruit among you just as I have seen with so many non-Jewish believers.*" (Romans 1:13 VOC)
