"Jesus being designed by God a 'High Priest"

Hebrew 5:10-12


Hebrews 5:10 KJV: '... called of God an High Priest after the order of Melchizedek'.

Hebrews 5:10 AMP: '...being <u>designated</u> and <u>recognized</u> and <u>saluted</u> by God as High Priest after the order of Melchizedek.'

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Hebrews 5:10 VOC: 'for God appointed Him to be a High Priest in the order of Melchizedek.'
Hebrews 5:10 WEB: ' <u>named</u> by God a High Priest after the order of Melchizedek.'
Hebrews 5:10 GNT: ' and God declared Him to be High Priest, in the priestly order of Melchizedek.'
1. Remember what this 'MELCHI-ZEDEK' means? MELCHI means 'my' of ZEDEK means ''.
2. Who appointed, called, designated, recognized, saluted, appointed, named, and declared Jesus to be a "HIGH PRIEST" after the order (rank) of Melchizedek?
3. Psalms 2:7-6: "I will declare the decree of the Lord: 'He said to Me, 'You are My Son; this day have I begotten You'.'" (v. 7) "I have installed My King on Zion, My holy hill." (v. 6)
WARNING AGAINST APOSTASY
Hebrews 5:11 KJV: 'Of whom we have many things to say, and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are <u>dull</u> <u>of hearing</u> ."
Hebrews 5:11 AMP: 'Concerning this we have much to say which is hard to explain, since you have become dull in your [spiritual] hearing and sluggish [even slothful in achieving spiritual insight].
Hebrews 5:11 CEV: 'Much more could be said about this subject. But it is hard to explain, and all of you are slow to understand.'
Hebrews 5:11 GW: 'We have a lot to explain about this. But since you have become too lazy to pay attention, explaining it to you is hard.'
Hebrews 5:11 MSG: 'I have a lot more to say about this, but it is hard to get it across to you since you've picked up this bad habit of not listening.'
4. What this word 'apostasy' means to you? It means 'a total desertion of or departure from one's religion, principles, party, cause, etc. Or a standing away, withdrawing.'

5. FOR EXAMPLE in John 6:60-69: When they heard this, many of His disciples said, "This is

a hard saying. Who can listen to it?" (v. 60) Jesus said to them, "Does this offend you?" (v. 61) Jesus said, "The Words that I speak to you are spirit and are life, but there are some of you who do not believe." (v. 63-64) From that time ______ of His disciples went back and walked no more with Him. (v. 66) So Jesus said to His 12 disciples, "Do you also want to go away?" (v. 67) Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have



In what way can your spiritual ear easily become dull-not listening God's Word?

Hebrews 5:12 MEV: 'For though by now you should be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God and have come to need milk rather than solid food.'

Hebrews 5:12 CPV: 'You all have had plenty of time to be teacher by now, and yet you still need somebody to teach you the kindergarten stuff of the Gospel'.

Hebrews 5:12 MSG: 'By this time <u>you ought to be teachers yourselves</u>, yet here I find you need someone to sit down with you and go over the basics on God again, starting from square one baby's milk, when you should have been on solid food long ago!'

Hebrews 5:12 VOC: 'By this time, you ought to be teachers yourselves, yet I feel like you want me to reteach you the most basic things that God wants you to know. It's almost like you're a baby again, coddled at your mother's breast, nursing, not ready for solid food.'
