Further Reflection for 7/18

1. What do you think you would feel if you were a person who had to live in exile in another place that was not your home?
2. How might we as Christians, think about living as in exile until the day Jesus returns?
3. Why do we often not hear the messages we should hear and instead hear what we want?
4. Read Jeremiah 26-28. What do you think about the interaction of Jeremiah and Hananiah?
5. Read Jeremiah 29:1-14. Why is it important to think about this passage as to a whole people and not an individual? How might this passage inform how we live now?
6. Read Jeremiah 31 and think about which phrases jump out at you.
7. Pray this prayer: "Father, help me to live as a citizen of your Kingdom. May I live as a person who seeks the best for where I live and recognize my primary residence is the Kingdom of God. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen."
