Further Study - July 5, 2020

Spring Training: Celebration

Throughout this series we will try and make many resources available to you. They will be listed on the website under the tab "Spring Training." Group leaders, use a few of the questions or Scriptures for your conversations.

Scriptures for Contemplation

- Sunday: The Lord has triumphed gloriously / Exodus 15:1–2, 20–21.
- Monday: The joy of the Lord / 2 Samuel 6:12–19.
- Tuesday: Bless the Lord / Psalm 103.
- Wednesday: Praise the Lord / Psalm 150.
- Thursday: Hosanna! / Luke 19:35–40, John 12:12–19.
- Friday: Walking and leaping and praising God / Acts 3:1–10.
- Saturday: Hallelujah! / Revelation 19:1–8.

Questions and Reflections

1. Do you enjoy God?
2. There is a body of teaching that instructs us to praise God *for* all things; there is another that urges us to praise God *in* all things. Do you feel that the difference between these two bodies of teaching is significant? If so, why?
3. Why do you think a wholesome evening of side-splitting laughter with friends does you so much good?
4. Why do you think human beings often find celebration so difficult?
5. Which do you like better: spontaneous bursts of joy or planned expressions of celebration? Why?
6. How about planning a family, non-holiday celebration this year?
7. Do you find it easy to laugh at yourself?
8. At the close of this study, what covenant *must* you make with the Lord?
9. What covenant can you make that will open the door to worship more effectively for you?
