
## Things You Should Know!

## Further Reflection for 3/2

1. What is the area of your life that you are most likely to compare yourself to someone else? Why is that?
2. Read Matthew 19:23-30
3. What jumps out to you from the text?
4. How does this passage make you think about your own faith?
5. Read John 21:15-22
6. What jumps out to you from the text?
7. Why does Jesus ask Peter three times about whether or not he loves him? What does Jesus' response tell us about how we are called to live?
8. Peter has just been "reinstated" by Jesus and is still worried about what is going on with John. Why do you think that is?
9. Is there an area that you struggle in your own faith because you are looking with some form of envy on the faith of another?
10. To consecrate something is to give something that is "ordinary" or "secular" to be made holy. God wants to consecrate us. Is there anything in your life that you need to give to God to be made holy? This week spend time in prayer surrendering whatever in your life is keeping you from being holy.
