- 2. must be derived from scripture alone. v3-4, 2 Timothy 3;16-17, 2 Peter 1:20-21
- 3. reflects the reality of our condition. v5, Romans 3:11, 8:8
 - a. The harness of our hearts. Zechariah 7:12
 - b. Our inability to do God's revealed (perfect) will. Is 50:1, Jer 3:1,8-9
- 4. aims for God's revealed will. v6-12, Micah 6:8
 - a. One man and one woman. v6, Genesis 2:24
 - b. Leave old life and begin a new life together as one. v7-8, Malachi 2:15; Ephesians 6:4
 - c. Only God should end a marriage. v9, Romans 7:1-3, 1 Cor. 7:8-16,39-40
 - d. God does not want us to end a marriage. v10-12, Ephesians 5:21-23
