1 Timothy 3:1-13;  
Titus 1:5-9

1 Corinthians 12:1-31

***4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism; 6 one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. 7 But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of the gift of Christ. 8 Therefore it says, "When he ascended on high he captured captives; he gave gifts to men."...11 It was [Jesus] who gave some as apostles, some as prophets, some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, 12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, that is, to build up the body of Christ,... 15 But practicing the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into Christ, who is the head. 16 From him the whole body grows, fitted and held together through every supporting ligament. As each one does its part, the body grows in love.***  
(Ephesians 4:4-8, 11-16, NET)

***4 Now there are different gifts, but the same Spirit. 5 And there are different ministries, but the same Lord. 6 And there are different results, but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. 7 To each person the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the benefit of all. 8 For one person is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, and another the message of knowledge according to the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,... 11 It is one and the same Spirit, distributing as he decides to each person, who produces all these things. 12 For just as the body is one and yet has many members, and all the members of the body—though many—are one body, so too is Christ. 13 For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body...27 Now you are Christ's body, and each of you is a member of it. 28 And God has placed in the church first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, gifts of healing, helps, gifts of leadership, different kinds of tongues....***

▶ **There are only TWO church leadership offices in the local church:  
Elders and Deacons.**

1. There are MULTIPLE Elders and Deacons serving at one local church.
2. Elders, and likely Deacons, are to be MEN ONLY.
3. Elders and Deacons must be SERVANT LEADERS.
4. Elder and Deacons have different roles: Elders focus on the SPIRITUAL NEEDS & Deacons focus on the PHYSICAL NEEDS of the local church.
5. Elders and Deacons are APPOINTED, not voted into office.
