- 1. The **CREATOR** became a _____.
- **Hebrews 2:9 AMP:** “But we do see Jesus, who was made lower than the angels for a little while [by taking on the limitations of humanity], crowned with glory and honor because of His suffering of death, so that by the grace of God [extended to sinners] He might experience death for [the sins of] everyone.”
- 2. The **SHEPHERD** became a _____.
- **Luke 2:7 KJV:** “And she (Mary) brought forth [giving birth] her **FIRSTBORN** Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes [to bind a newborn infant in strips of long cloth, a normal act of child care for warmth, security, etc., and laid Him in a manger [put Him to rest in a feeding-trough (crib)]; because there was no room for them in the inn [guest room, an eating room, dining room].”
