- 2. Read Mark 13:24-37
- 3. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 4. Jesus uses everyday prophetic language from his day in what he says, why might he choose to do that?
- 5. Why do you think people become fixated on end times things?
- 6. Notice that Jesus says that about the day or the hour in which he will return that no one but the Father knows. How then should we think about end times?
- 7. Jesus makes it clear that his followers are to "keep watch." What is Jesus trying to say?
- 8. How does the way we live impact our understanding of keeping watch?
- 9. What are practices you could put in to your daily life that would lead to living more like God's Kingdom has already come "on earth as it is in heaven."
