<u>Prayer Requests</u> can be submitted via the website under the Ministries tab. These prayer requests go directly to Pastor Aaron and are confidential.



## Further Reflection for 4/30

- When is a moment that you responded to someone/ something in a way you regret?
- 2. When is a moment you suffered through something and it taught you perseverance?
- 3. Read 1 Peter 2:18-25
- 4. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 5. Peter shares that followers of Jesus are called to suffering. Why might that be important?
- 6. Verses 21-25 lay out that Jesus is the suffering servant.
  What do those verses spell out for how we are called to live?
- 7. Think of a moment whereby your suffering could lead to another coming to follow Jesus?
- 8. Reflect this week on what area of life you may need to surrender to God. Often we choose lives without suffering by virtue of what we are unwilling to surrender. Ask the Holy Spirit to open your eyes as you spend 5-10 minutes in silence each morning.
