Further Reflection for 10/9

Reflection:

- 1. When is a moment when you were irrationally afraid?
- 2. When have you experienced an obstacle or an opportunity in your life? Why would you describe it as that?

Study:

- 1. Read Revelation 3:7-13
 - a. What jumps out to you from the text?
 - b. What is encouraging about the idea that God is the one who opens and closes the doors?
 - c. Thinking about the reality that God knows your deeds. What does that make you think?
 - d. John describes the people of the church in Philadelphia as enduring patiently, does that describe your faith? Why or why not?
 - e. What images come to mind when you read verse 12? What does this verse tell us about what God is doing in the future?
 - f. Verse 13 says "whoever has ears to hear, let them hear...," do you have ears to hear what God is trying to say? Why or why not?
 - g. Is repenting something you do well or often? Why or why not?
 - h. What is an area of faith where you tend to see obstacles rather than opportunities? (and vice versa)

Application:

1. What is one step you can make to bear a more faithful witness to Jesus in your everyday life?

Prayer:

Father, help me to see not just obstacles but opportunities. Open my eyes to see the world from your perspective. In Jesus' name I Pray. Amen.

Spiritual Practice:

- Pray daily this week for God to give you an opportunity to live out your faith with others.
- Spend time in silent reflection on where God may be calling you to see obstacles.
