Reflection:

- 1. Do you remember the first time someone handed you a set of keys? How did it make you feel?
- 2. Do you remember a time when someone trusted you with something very important? How did you respond?
- 3. When someone younger or less experienced than you is trusted with leadership, how does that make you feel?

Study:

- 1. Read Matthew 10:1-8
 - a. What jumps out to you?
 - b. What does this passage say about Jesus' view of his disciples?
 - c. How would you respond to the task Jesus gives his disciples?
- 2. Read Matthew 17:14-20
 - a. What jumps out to you about Jesus' response to the situation?
 - b. Do you feel that Jesus was too harsh? Why?
- 3. Read Matthew 28:16-20
 - a. What does this call to make disciples look like in your life?

Application:

- 1. What can you do to empower the next generation of leaders?
- 2. What area of life do you need to step up and be willing to take leadership and responsibility in?
- 3. Tell someone the potential you see in them because they may not see it themselves.

Prayer:

Father, help me to have the courage to both step up when I need to step up and to do everything I can to set up the next generation of leaders to hold the keys. In Jesus' name I Pray. Amen.

Spiritual Practice:

 Practice seeing people for what they could do and encourage them based upon their potential.
