

2. Verse one quotes the _____ of the blessed or happy man.

3. We see the **NEGATIVE** side of the practice of the blessed man. We are told **WHAT** the happy man does _____ **DO**. Here we see three positions. **HAPPY** is the man:

- who does not _____ in the counsel of the ungodly,
- who does not _____ in the way of sinners, or
- who does not _____ in the seat of the scornful.

4. The person **DOES** these three things is _____ happy person.

5. The person goes through three stages:



- **FIRST** he associates with the _____,
- **THEN** he gets in with _____, and
- **FINALLY** he joins in with the _____.

6. Listening to the counsel of the ungodly is _____ walking by faith. Who are the ungodly? They are the people who just leave _____ out. The ungodly counsels the man, and now we find him standing in the way of sinners. It is the sinner who takes him from there. Sin means to 'miss the mark'. The sinner have gone _____ and have turn every one to his own way. The next step from standing in the way of sinners is sitting in the seat of the scornful. And we are told that the third stage is that he sits in the seat of the scornful (or mocker). The scornful is the _____. The scornful-they are the ones who are absolutely _____ to God. They don't want the Bible read in the public schools; they don't want the Bible read anywhere for that matter.
