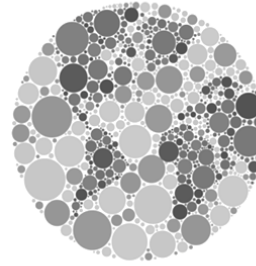

Hebrews 2:5-9

Crowned with Glory and Honor

Pastor Richard

1. God created man (the first Adam) to **rule** over **creation**. (vv. 5-8a)
2. The first Adam **sinned** and was **subjected** to death. (v. 8b)
3. Jesus (the second Adam) **defeated** death and **restored** the hope of Psalm 8 for man. (v. 9)
4. In the world to come, Christians will **reign** with Christ over **creation**. (vv. 5-9)
