Further Reflection for 10/27

1. When is a moment that when you look back someone said something to you that still carries great significance? How did it make you feel then? How does it make you feel now?
2. Read John 17:1-19
3. What jumps out to you from the text?
4. How does Jesus define "eternal life" in this passage? Why is that significant?
5. What does verse 5 tell you about the relationship of Jesus with the Father?
6. Jesus asks God to protect his followers in verses 11, 12, and 15. What is he asking them to protect them from? (Hint: it is not for physical safety)
7. Why is verse 15 so important for followers of Jesus?
8. Verse 18 shares that Jesus is sending his followers into the world, as he was sent. What does that mean for your life?
9. John writes earlier in chapter 1 that Jesus is the Word of God in flesh and here Jesus prays that his followers would be sanctified by God's word. How can you understand these things together?
10. This week, spend time reading the very words of Jesus. He is the Word of God, and knowing and embracing his words will move us toward being sanctified as he is sanctified.
