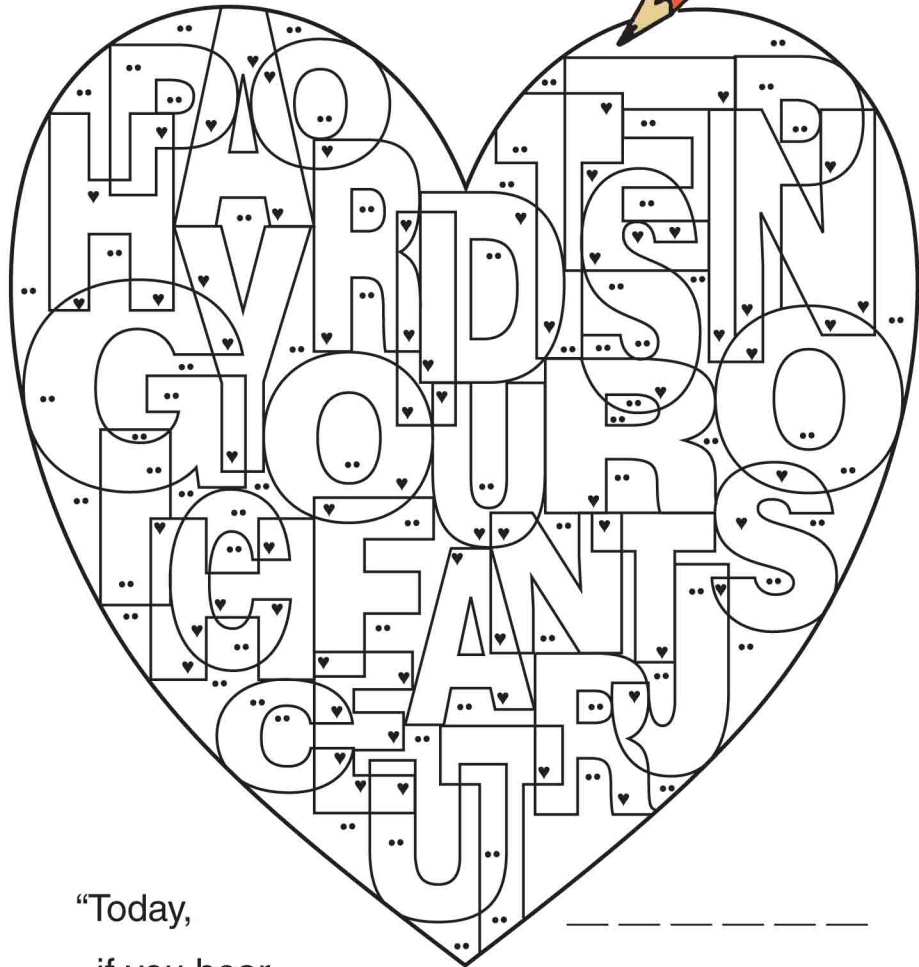


The psalm gives instructions about what to do if you hear the voice of the Lord.
