INGATHERING

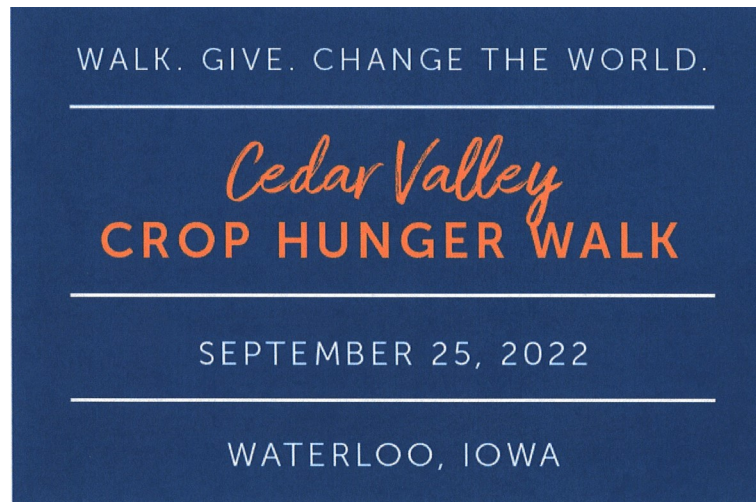
Do you like to sew? We need people to sew baby blankets for ingathering kits. If you can help, talk to Donna Brown or Dorothy Wright.
