Further Reflection for 5/28

- 1. Who's voice had the most influence on you as you were growing up? Who's voice has the most influence on you now?
- 2. What are the things that you listen to most often? Do they influence you to be more or less like Jesus?
- 3. Read John 10:1-30
- 4. What jumps out to you from the text?
- 5. How often has someone used a figure of speech and you did not understand it? Why did you not understand it? Why do you think the Pharisees struggled to understand?
- 6. Jesus says his sheep know his voice. How do you come to know his voice more and more?
- 7. Jesus said to the Pharisees "I did tell you, but you did not believe." What keeps us from believing that Jesus is who he says he is?
- 8. You and I can rest in the fact that Jesus tells us that no one and no thing can snatch us from the hand of the Father who loves us. Why should that give you comfort?
- 9. Spend time daily this week with Jesus. Begin each morning and allow for silence and solitude to guide your day. Begin with this simple prayer, "Jesus, help me to hear your voice." Spend 10-20 minutes in silence and every time your mind begins to wander, pray that prayer again.
