## FOOD NOOK VOLUNTEERS

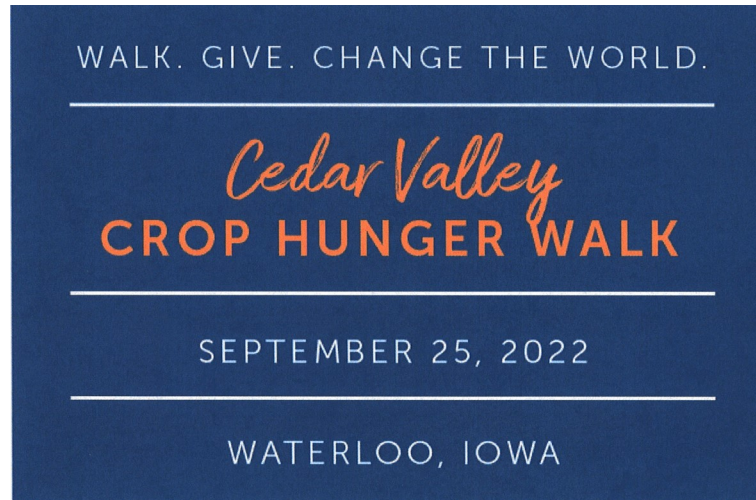
