Reflection:

- 1. Have you ever experienced something that didn't meet your expectations?
- 2. Tell about a time when you didn't get what you think you wanted, but instead, got something better.
- 3. AW Tozer famously said, "What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us." Is this true? If so, how do you think it impacts our lives?
- 4. When you picture God, what do you picture?

Study:

- 1. Read Matthew 21:1-11
 - a. What stands out to you from this passage?
 - b. Why is that the people go from praising Jesus in this passage, to wanting him crucified only a few days later?
 - c. In what ways is Jesus a different kind of King than the people expected? Why were people so bothered with his way or ruling?
 - d. Read verse 10-11: Who is Jesus to you? How is that reflected in your life?
 - e. As a group, discuss what it looks like to grow closer to Jesus individually and as a community.

Challenge:

- 1. People are often introduced to Jesus through our behaviors, words, and actions. If this is the case, are we helping people to see an honest picture of Christ?
- 2. How can we better embody the real identity of Christ in our lives?

God, today we pray to know you. We want to know the real Christ, who is our hope and king. We pray for peace and joy this Easter season as we are reminded of your love and mercy. May we choose love over hate, and be ambassadors of Jesus this week and beyond. Amen.
