John 15:2 AMPC: "Any branch in Me that does not bear fruit [that stops bearing] He cuts away (trims off, takes away); and He cleanse and repeatedly prunes every branch that continues to bear fruit, make it bear more and richer and more excellent fruit."

4. Scripture says at least two things about the JUDGMENT of unfruitful branches that _____.
 - a) The unfruitful branches that sin are taken away and removed from the Vine and destroyed by _____. John 15:6 EXB: “If any do not remain [abide] in Me, they are like a branch that thrown away and then dies [withers; dries up]. People pick up [gather together] dead branches, throw them into the fire, and burn them.”
 - b) The unfruitful branches that sin are chastened and disciplined by being taken away and removed through _____. The Bible warns professing believers of severe (serious) chastening, the chastening of...
 - sinful behavior that causes _____ of all rewards by fire—a _____ so great a man or woman is stripped as much as burned-out building. It is the _____ of all except the very salvation of man. “But if the building [work] is burned up, the builder will suffer loss [or be fined; or be punished]. The builder will be saved, but it will be as one who escaped from a fire [through fire].” (1 Corinthians 3:15 EXB)
 - sinful behavior that “then hand this man over to Satan. So his sinful self will be _____ [sinful nature will be purged; or body/flesh will be destroyed; or body will be beaten down by sin], and his (human) spirit will be saved on the day of the Lord.” (1 Corinthians 5:5 EXB)
 - sinful behavior that causes _____. “...there is sin [or a sin] that leads to [eternal] death [probably referring to the false teachers, their rejection of the Spirit’s work having put them beyond repentance; see Mark 3:29]...” (1 John 5:16)
 - sinful behavior that merits (defines ‘to be worthy of; deserve) _____ escape. “So be careful and [see that you] do not refuse to listen when God speaks. If those who refused to listen to Him when He warned them on earth did not escape, how much worse will it be for us if we refuse to listen to God who warns us from heaven?” (Hebrews 12:25 EXB)
 - sinful behavior that _____ man from ever repenting again. “It is impossible to restore the changed heart of the one who has fallen from faith—who has already been enlightened, has tasted the gift of new life from God, has shared in the power of the Holy Spirit...” (Hebrews 6:4 VOC)
 - sinful behavior that prohibits any future sacrifice for sins and merits terrible punishment. “Now if we willfully persist in sin after receiving such knowledge of the truth, then there is no sacrifice left for those sins—” (Hebrews 10:26 VOC)
