The Things That Are Letters to the 7 churches Sardis



Intro: Dead churches are those that exhibit the following characteristics:

- 1. They maintain a soft hermeneutical position,
- 2. They deny the literal Millennial reign of Christ,
- 3. They deny Israel's prophetic destiny,
- 4. There's an absence of a Biblical devotional life,
- 5. There's a de emphasis of 1 Corinthians 15:1-4.

The Resurrection is the foundation of our Christian experience.

The City

- One of the oldest.
- Very wealthy due to Gold being found in the Pactolus.
- Failed to be watchful and diligent. As a result it was a city of Failure;
 - 1. Pretensions unjustified,
 - 2. Promise without performance
 - 3. Appearance without reality
 - 4. False confidence that heralded ruin,

The Church

Nothing in scripture tells us when or by whom it was founded.

There is no mention in the letter of:

- 1. Persecution,
- 2. false doctrine,
- 3. False teachers, or,
- 4. Immoral lifestyle

They didn't need a doctor to cure them of their ills, they needed a mortician. They were Dead.

A. The Correspondant:

- 1. Title of Christ taken from John's vision in chapter 1.
- 2. The phrase, "seven spirits of God" refers to the completeness or fullness of the Holy Spirit.
- 3. The number "7" also refers to perfection in scripture.

Isaiah gives us several characteristics of the Holy Spirit in **Isaiah 11:1-2.**

B. The Concern:

- 1. No commendation, only condemnation.
- 2. The phrase, "I know your works" speaks to Christ's omniscience.
- 3. That their works were not 'satisfactory' to God shows they had no relationship with Him. **Matt. 7:21-23.**
- 4. They looked good to the community, but were like stuffed animals in a museum. Dead!

C. The Council:

There are five steps given to restoration:

- 1. Wake up; pay strict attention to your circumstances.
- 2. Strengthen the things that remain.
- 3. Remember the truth of the Gospel
- 4. Keep, or put into practice the truths they knew.
- 5. Repent.

D. The Promise to Overcomers:

- A. They will be clothed in white garments;
 - 1. White stands for purity,
 - 2. Garments stand for character.
- B. Their name remains in the book of life
 - 1. Their eternal security is secure.
 - 2. They are introduced as family to God.

Conclusion

Sardis was called out for their lack of <u>watchfulness</u> and <u>diligence</u>. We need to be watchful for:

- 1. The wiles of the devil, 1 Peter 5:8
- 2. Temptation, Matt. 26:41
- 3. His coming, Matt. 24:42-43; Mk. 13:37; 1 Thess. 5:6
- 4. False teachers, Acts 20:28-31.

We need to be diligent about:

- 1. Confronting sin in our midst, Matt. 18:15-20
- 2. Maintaining separation from the world, John 17:15-16
- 3. Not being complacent in our walk, Phil. 3:12-14.
