JOHN 14:13-14

John 14:13-14 KJV: Jesus said, "And whatsoever you shall ask in My Name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. **(14)** If you shall ask any thing in My Name, I will do it."

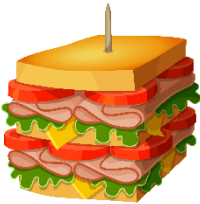
John 14:13-14 TPT: "For I will do whatever you ask Me to do when you ask Me in My Name. And that is how the Son will show what the Father is really like and bring glory to Him. **(14)** Ask Me anything in My Name, and I will do it for you!"

John 14:13-14 MSG: "From now on, whatever you request along the lines of who I am and what I am doing, I'll do it. That's how the Father will be seen for who He is in the Son. I mean it. Whatever you request in this way, I'll do."

John 14:13-14 AMPC: "And I will do [I Myself will grant] whatever you ask in My Name [as presenting all that I AM], so that the Father may be glorified and extolled and celebrated in (through) the Son. **(14)** [Yes] I will grant [I Myself will do for you] whatever you shall ask in My Name [as presenting all that I AM]."

1. Smith Wigglesworth's comment: "Many people miss a great many things because they are always thinking that they are for someone else."

☞ There are two breads between them. Many Christians struggled or frustrated with their prayer life with no answer. Let's examine here:



✍ **John 14:12:** "Truly, truly," I say unto you, "He that believes in Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do because I go unto My Father."

✍ **John 14:15:** "If you love Me, you will keep (obey) My commandments."

2. Look at **1 John 5:14-15:** "And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He hears us: and if we know that He hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him." Let's look at different translations here:

✍ **1 John 5:14-15 VOC:** "We live in the bold confidence that God hears our voices when we ask for things that fit His plan. And if we have no doubt that He hears our voices, we can be assured that He move in response to our call."

✍ **1 John 5:14-15 TPT:** "Since we have this confidence, we can also have great boldness before Him, for if we ask anything agreeable to His will, He will hear us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we also know that we have obtained the requests we ask of Him."

✍ **1 John 5:14-15 TLB:** “And we are sure of this, that he will listen to us whenever we ask Him for anything in line with His will. And if we really know He is listening when we talk to Him and make our requests, then we can be sure that He will answer us.”

✍ **1 John 5:14-15 ERV:** “We can come to God with no doubts. This means that when we ask God for things (and those things agree with what God wants for us), God cares about what we say. He listens to us every time we ask Him. So we know that He gives us whatever we ask from Him.”

(John 14:12)

7. For example: **Acts 4:24 to 31**

☞ When they heard this, they lifted their voices in **UNITY** to God and prayed, “Lord, You are God, who has made the heaven and the earth and the sea and everything in them. **(v. 24)**

☞ And who by the mouth of Your servant David said: “Why did the nation rage, and the people devise vain things? **(v. 25)**

☞ The kings of the earth came, and the rulers were assembled together against the Lord and against His Christ.” **(v. 26)**

☞ ...to do what Your hand and Your counsel had foreordained to be done. **(v. 28)**

☞ Now, Lord, look on their threats and grant that Your servants may speak Your Word with great boldness, **(v. 29)**

☞ ...by stretching out Your hand to heal and that signs and wonders may be performed in the Name of Your holy Son Jesus.” **(v. 30)**

☞ When they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the Word of God with boldness.” **(v. 31)**

8. At closure, what your attitude should be in this **John 11:40-42**: Could you follow His example? Then your prayer answers easily?

✍ Jesus said to her, “Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?...Jesus lifted up His eyes and said, ‘Father, I thank You that You have heard Me. I know that You always hear Me. But because of the people standing around, I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me’.”
