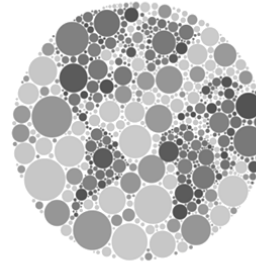

What do the Bible's last words teach us about missions?

1. The church must proclaim Jesus' coming.

- His coming is imminent. (vv. 7, 10, 12, 20)

- His coming is exclusive. (vv. 7, 12)

2. The church should pray for Jesus' coming. (vs. 20)
