Reflection:

- What is the area of your life that is most difficult in terms of following Jesus? Why do you think that is?
- 3. When have you been able to be there for someone else in a way that they told you it mattered?

Study:

- 1. Read 1 Timothy 4:12-15
 - a. What jumps out to you?
 - b. From this passage what is the relationship between Timothy and Paul?
 - c. List the various things that are ways that Paul encourages Timothy to live?
 - d. Paul not only tells Timothy how to live, but he reminds him of his gift. Why is that important if you are ever going to invite someone to live differently?
 - e. How might Paul's words help Timothy in terms of his identity?
- 2. Read Matthew 11:28-30
 - a. What about these words is good news for you today? How might these words help in connecting with younger people today?
 - b. As a follower of Jesus we are called to live like Jesus. Throughout the gospels we see Jesus help those in need and show an interest in them. How might you put that into practice in your own life?

Application:

- 1. What can you do to encourage someone else in their faith and life today?
- 2. Who is someone that God may have laid on your heart to reach and connect with?
- 3. Write a note and thank a person who has been there for you in a tough moment in life.

Prayer:

Father, help me to trust you for defining who I am. Help me to be a person who speaks life into others and listens to them as you listen to me. In Jesus' name I Pray. Amen.

Spiritual Practice:

Practice listening to people who have different experiences than
you, are a different age than you are, or someone who is at a
different life stage than you.
