

A Faith that Works Controls the Tongue

Main Idea: The words that we say are a reflection of the genuineness of faith in our hearts.

1. Christian teachers are held to a high standard with how they use their words. (vv. 1-2)
2. Spirit controlled speech is a fruit of Christian maturity. (vv. 3-5a)
3. Uncontrolled speech flows from a heart unchanged by the gospel. (vv. 5b-12)
