Further Reflection for 11/20

Reflection:

- 1. When is a time you missed a part of a book/movie/tv show and because you missed that part the whole thing either didn't make sense, or it changed the meaning of the book/movie/tv show?
- 2. What is a moment in life in which you experienced a radical transformation of someone/something? What did it make you feel?

Study:

- Read Revelation 21-22 (at a minimum read 21:1-5, 22-25; 22:1-5, 12-17)
 - a. What jumps out to you from the text?
 - b. Are there any images/illustrations that John writes that reminded you of other biblical texts? If so, which ones?
 - c. 21:1-5 John shares a picture of a moment in which heaven and earth become one, God is present with all humanity, and what that brings about. How might this passage impact your present life?
 - d. 21:22-25 speaks of nations and it likely includes what we think of in regards to nations, but it speaks even more so to the reality that all cultures and people groups will be gathered together. How might that impact the way we try to live?
 - e. 22:1-5 speaks of the restoration of Eden. How might that idea be valuable for you today?
 - f. Read 22:12-17 aloud and answer the following question. How might we receive God's life for us, here and now, not just in the future?

Application:

1. How might you take one step to live as God's New Creation, here and now?

Prayer:

Father, help me to recognize that you are making all things new. May I honestly, humbly allow you to make me new. In Jesus' name I Pray. Amen.

Spiritual Practice:

- Begin each day this week thinking on where you find life.
- End each day this week reflecting on where you find life.
