

A Faith that Works Is Not Self-Reliant

Main Idea: Money will not satisfy your heart because it is a false god. So, be careful how you use your money.

1) Money is temporary and perishable. (vv. 2-3)

2) The love of money leads to abuse and injustice. (v. 4)

3) Loving money causes us to live for the pleasures of this world and not for the pleasures of heaven. (vv. 5-6)
