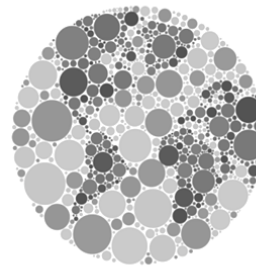

Hebrews 2:14-18

*Able to Help*

1. Jesus is able to help because He took on **flesh**. (v.14)
2. Jesus is able to help because He **died** for us. (v.14)
3. Jesus is able to help because He defeated the **devil**. (v.14)
4. Jesus is able to help because He freed us from **slavery** to fear. (v.15)
5. Jesus is able to help because He is our perfect elder **brother**. (v.17)
6. Jesus is able to help because He is our high **priest**. (v.17)
7. Jesus is able to help because He is **merciful** and **faithful**. (v.17)
8. Jesus is able to help because He is the **propitiation** for our sins. (v.17)
9. Jesus is able to help because He **suffered**. (v.18)
10. Jesus is able to help because He was **tempted**. (v.18)
