Message Series: Psalm 9 — Whole Heart

Message Title: Contrast between Destruction vs. Hope and Help

Psalm 9 is a \_\_\_\_\_  
—written by David when he was under stress and pressure.

In the first part of Psalm 9 (v. 1-12) David is praising God for rescuing and protecting him. David's words are directed to the \_\_\_\_\_ who are listening to his song.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> part of it, however, shows a heart filled with fear and in those verses we find David speaking directly to \_\_\_\_\_.
