The saving faith of the gospel produces a justified life available to all Christians.

Justification is an act of God in which he declares that our sins forgiven, Christ's perfect life is imputed to us, and we are seen as righteous in His sight.

A Christian's faith produces;

1. obedience to God. v20-21, Genesis 22:1-14, Matthew 16:24

2. righteousness before God. v22-23, Genesis 15:6, Psalm 33:18–22

b. Practical

3. a willingness to take risks for God. v24-26 Acts 1-28, Hebrews 11:31

Romans 5:1-2 Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through Him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
