- 3. What jumps out to you from the text?

- 5. The two disciples follow Jesus and he responds to their question, "Come, and you will see." Is there a moment that you followed someone knowing very little about them, but knew it was the right thing?
- 6. Both Andrew and Philip go to people that are important in their lives and invite them to experience what they have experienced in the presence of Jesus. When have you invited someone into the presence of Jesus? If not, why?
- 7. Nathaniel makes a joke that nothing good can come from Nazareth. Has there ever been a time in which your preconceived ideas have hindered you from seeing fully someone or something?
- 8. John the Baptist and Andrew are two characters in the New Testament that point beyond themselves for the sake of others. What is a way you could point beyond yourself for the sake of others?
