## OK, Let's Try This One More Time Mark 8:1-26

Jesus has the power to overcome our spiritual blindness and open our eyes that we may see.

A miracle is a less common kind of God's activity in which He arouses people's awe and wonder and bears witness to Himself.

## We can be spiritually blind;

**1. to the power of Jesus.** v1-9, Mark 9:23, 2 Peter 1:16

When you seek a miracle do you; assess the situation, check your resources, organize the situation, thank God for His provision and ask Him to bless our endeavor, understand that this work is for His benefit and glory, understand that this work will satisfy a need, not a want, see how additional blessings will flow out from this one event?

- **2. to the purpose of Jesus.** v10-13, John 6:26, Luke 19:10 To live in unbelief is to; test the Lord, grieve the Lord, and lose the Lord
- **3. to the potential dangers of unbelief.** v14-21, Mark 9:15-29, 5:31-34, Philippians 4:12-13 Don't let the unbelief of others influence you and divert your attention from the divine truth of the gospel.
- **4.** to the progressive nature of understanding Jesus. v22-26, Hebrews 4:12, 1:1-2 We do not get to understand everything all at once, be patient and learn what God reveals to you incrementally.
