When you encounter disappointment along the road, the enemy will also try to convince you that all is lost. However, the truth is that you gain much in the spiritual realm, growing in stature while increasing in wisdom and anointing. The devil, who is a liar, wants you to lose hope, believing the issue will never be resolved, and that it is over forever. He makes it appear that the problems are too great for Me to address. Those doubts drain your spirit and hinder your progress toward maturity. He also wants you to forsake your divine purpose and destiny by letting go of your vision.

My child, disappointment is an inevitable fact of life. As you're alive, there will be highs and lows, ups and downs, laughter and weeping, happiness and sadness. Life can sometimes feel like a perilous roller coaster ride. Many struggle with feelings of despair when things go wrong. When dreams are shattered and hope dies, disappointment is the natural result. Pain is inevitable. Why? Because you are in a fallen world.

But I don't want that to hinder you in any way. In order for you to have everything I want to give you, you'll have to let go of bitterness and dump every heavy weight at My feet so I can set you free and heal your disappointment. However, that will never happen until you let go of your right to be angry. I can turn every dark thing around for your good if you dump it in My lap.

My still, small voice will comfort you through My Word:

"Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with My victorious right hand." (Isaiah 41:10)

I will be your **STRENGTH**, your **HOPE**, your **COMFORT**, and your **COUNSELOR**. In times of weakness I will be faithful to meet your needs and lift you above your circumstances. Trust Me to be everything you need, for I am always more than enough!
