#47 SERMON NOTE 2019

A.S.K.

(LUKE 11:1-13)

"So it is with your prayers. **A**sk and you'll receive. **S**eek and you'll discover. **K**nock on heaven's door, and it will one day open for you. Every persistent person will get what he asks for. Every persistent seeker will discover what he needs. And everyone who knocks persistently will one day find an open door." (v. 9-10 TPT)

1. **Y N NS:** Are you a persistent person will get what you ask for?
2. **Y N NS:** Are you a persistent seeker what you discover what you need?
3. **Y N NS:** Are you a persistent person knocks will one day find an open door?
4. Look at John 15:7 KJV: "If you abide in Me (Jesus-the Vine), and My Words abide in you (the branch), you shall ask what you will, and it shall be done unto you."

- 'Abide' in Greek word 'meno' means 'to be held, kept, continually, to continue to be, endure, to survive, live, to remain as one, not to become another or different, to wait for'.

- This is prayer. It's not the only kind of prayer, but it's one important kind of prayer. We ought to be pleading together with God-saying the _____ things God said in His Word.

5. Look at Isaiah 43:26 KJV: "Put Me in remembrance [to recall, to remind, be brought to mind, to record]: Let us (you and _____) plead [to act as lawgiver or judge] together [alike, union, united]: you declare [to count exactly or accurately, to recount, be numbered to be rehearsed, be related], that you may be justified [to declare righteous, just, innocence]."

- Put God in remembrance, pleading together, and declaring are all ways of verbalizing things. How do we verbalized? With _____. If we declare or say something, we should be saying something so we can be proven or shown to be right. If we do our part, God is ready to do His. He's just waiting to be _____. The word together is an important key. E.W. Kenyon quoted: "Prayer should be God looking down to earth and seeing a mirror reflecting His Word back at Him." 6. Look at Isaiah 62:6-7 AMPC: "I have set watchmen upon your walls, O Jerusalem, who will never hold their peace day or night; you who [are His servants and by your prayers] put the Lord in remembrance [of His promises], keep not silence, and give Him no rest until He establishes Jerusalem and makes her a praise in the earth."
