We will come to your home and assess your water use, check for leaks, optimize your irrigation schedule and even install water-efficient shower heads. A typical Water-Wise House Call takes about an hour and is available at your convenience Monday through Saturday. A similar free service is also available to businesses.

In addition, Valley Water has several rebate programs to help you save water at home or at your business. For example, you can receive a money-saving rebate if you buy a new water-saving clothes washer or irrigation hardware.

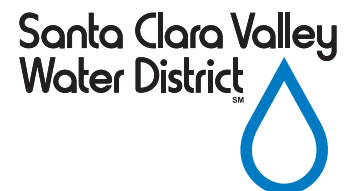
Our goal is to avoid mandatory restrictions on water use. That means, we all have to start conserving now. Remember, when it comes to saving water, there is no time to waste.

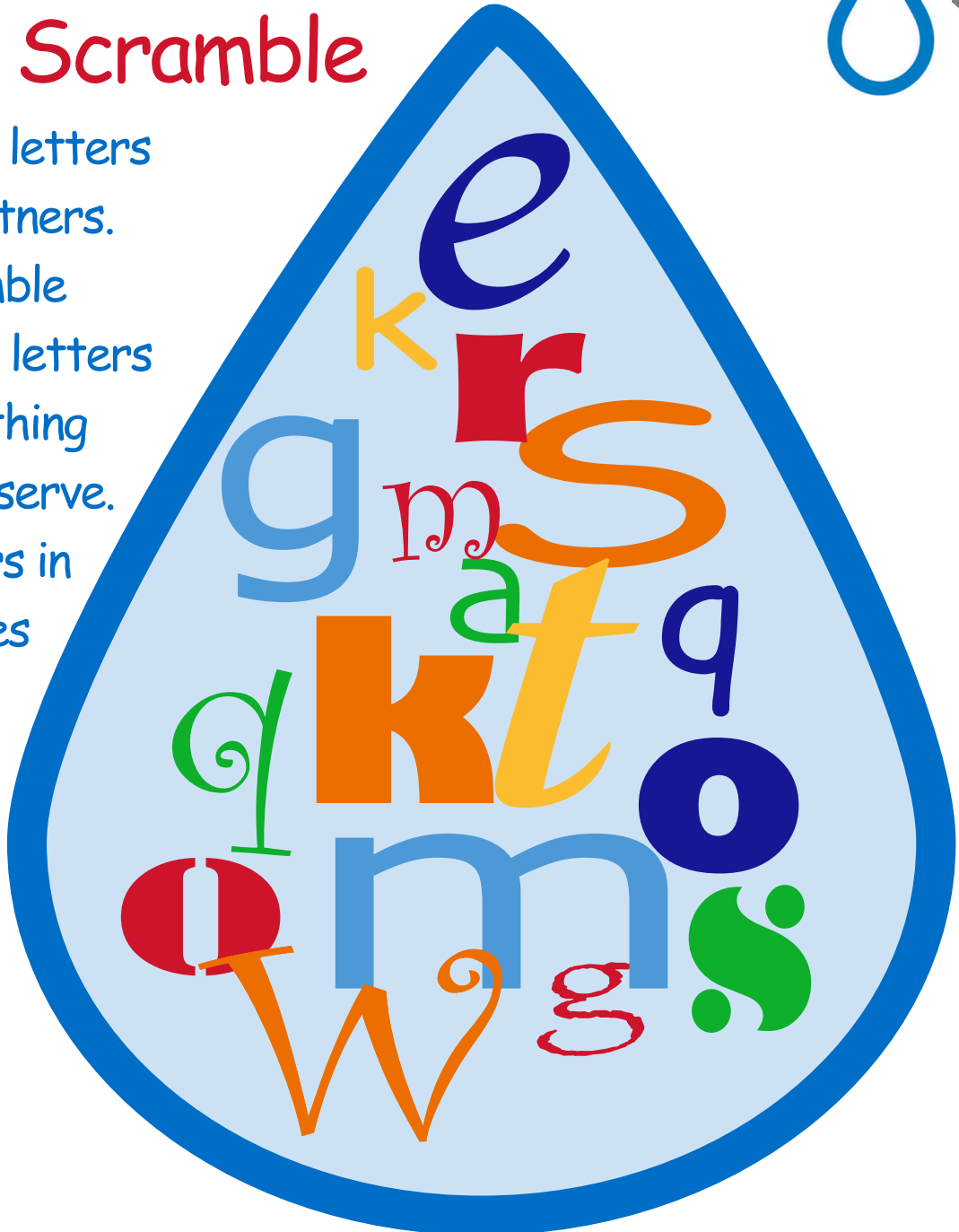

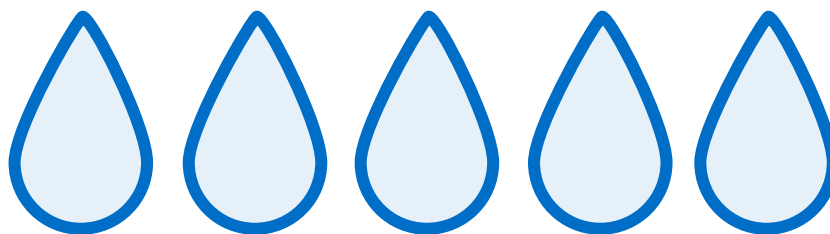


Letter Scramble
