- 1. Make a plan with my family so I will know what I must do to be safe.
- 2. Plan and practice our escape & post the plan.
- 3. Pick two places we can meet, one outside on the street and one not far.
- 4. Put together some supplies. Band-aids, water, comfort food, batteries, clocks, scissors, tweezers, juice, soup, toys and books. I'll go on line and find a list.
- 5. Teach 9-1-1 to one and all; when and how to make the call.
- 6. Keep storm drains clean and gutters clear.
- 7. Volunteer to clean a creek.
- 8. Don't walk through floodwaters.
- 9. Don't drive through flooded streets.
- 10. If our car stalls as waters rise, we'll get out quick.
