SUMMARY:

The Redistricting Project's consultants, Redistricting Partners, will present a set of two draft map plans for the Committee to review. The Committee Members will then discuss their preferred draft map plan(s) and if applicable, take into consideration any input received from the public or communities of interests throughout the outreach meetings for each of the seven Valley Water districts. The Committee may suggest potential changes to any of the draft map plans and Redistricting Partners will provide adjustments to these maps at the next meeting.

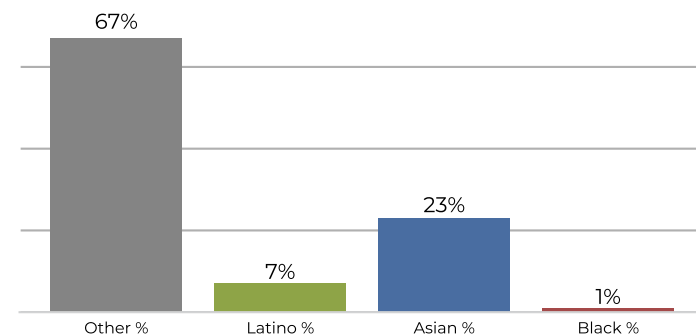
