No fiscal impact. This bill removes obsolete language from statute concerning Summary of

Fiscal Impact: cancer drug testing. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory

Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

This bill repeals an obsolete section of statute that requires the Department of Public Health and Environment to test substances, upon request, that are held out as having value in the diagnosis, treatment, alleviation, or cure of cancer.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill removes a section of statute that is obsolete, as this work is performed on the federal level by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. It will not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 2, 2019, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 3, 2019, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
