HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 25-1027

101 **CONCERNING DESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF COLORADO STATE**
102 **HIGHWAY 1 FROM EAST COUNTY ROAD 60 TO INTERSTATE 25**
103 **IN LARIMER COUNTY AS THE "COMMISSIONER LEW GAITER III**
104 **MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".**

1 WHEREAS, Commissioner Lewis "Lew" Leon Gaiter III was born
2 to Sandra and Lew Gaiter Jr., in Denver, Colorado, on November 21,
3 1959; and

4 WHEREAS, Commissioner Gaiter grew up in Littleton, Colorado,
5 graduating from Littleton High School in 1977, and attended Colorado
6 State University for two years before starting his career in the computer
7 industry; and

8 WHEREAS, Commissioner Gaiter married his wife, Jeannette, on

1 March 14, 1981, in Fort Collins, Colorado, going on to have nine
2 children; and

3 WHEREAS, During his career as a software engineer,
4 Commissioner Gaiter worked for companies, including Spectralogic,
5 Hewlett-Packard, United Airlines, and Colorado State University and ran
6 his own business, StarFire Enterprises; and

7 WHEREAS, A longtime resident of Larimer County,
8 Commissioner Gaiter was first appointed as the Larimer County
9 Commissioner representing District 1 in a vacancy election in January
10 2010 and was elected to the same position in November 2010 and
11 reelected in November 2014, going on to serve for eight years; and

12 WHEREAS, As a dedicated public servant, Commissioner Gaiter
13 served as chair of the Larimer County Board of Commissioners and
14 president of Colorado Counties, Inc., among many other roles; and

15 WHEREAS, Commissioner Gaiter was credited with promoting
16 rural broadband access, helping to develop a five-year strategic plan, and
17 supporting economic development work; and

18 WHEREAS, Commissioner Gaiter was an active member of the
19 Loveland Volunteer Ski Patrol for twenty-five years and a passionate
20 Denver Broncos fan and participated in the boards of various nonprofit
21 organizations, including Christian Home Educators of Colorado and
22 Realities for Children; and

23 WHEREAS, After a long battle with a rare blood cancer,
24 Commissioner Gaiter passed away peacefully on September 18, 2018,
25 with his wife, Jeannette, and other family members by his side; and

26 WHEREAS, Commissioner Gaiter is remembered as "a man of
27 great dedication to his work, strong faith, integrity, and courage"; now,
28 therefore,

29 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-fifth
30 General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:*

31 (1) That the portion of Colorado State Highway 1 in Larimer
32 County from East County Road 60 to Interstate 25 be designated as the
33 "Commissioner Lew Gaiter III Memorial Highway".
