Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$723,564 General Fund to the Judicial Department for FY 2021-22. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.9 FTE to implement the act.

Points to Consider

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package \$723,364 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill.
