Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes a provision that appropriates \$17,000,500 to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2021-22. The provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will receive \$10,000,500 federal funds to implement the act. Any money appropriated in the bill not expended prior to July 1, 2022 is further appropriated to the Department for FY 2022-23 for the same purpose.
