The bill contains an appropriations clause that reduces the General Fund appropriation by \$91,398 and 1.0 FTE for the disordered eating prevention program in the Prevention Services Division within the Department of Public Health and Environment.

### **General Fund Impact**

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2025-26 based on the March 2025 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2025-26 budget package a reduction of \$91,398 General Fund appropriations to be included in this bill.
