Committee on Appropriations.
After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB25-1214 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend the Finance Committee Report, dated April 7, 2025, page 2, line 7, strike "\$714,690" and substitute "\$886,023".
Page 2 of the report, line 8, strike "\$1,658,037" and substitute "\$2,707,387".
Page 2 of the report, line 9, strike "FISCL" and substitute "FISCAL".
Amend printed bill, page 13, before line 7 insert:
"SECTION 8. Appropriation - adjustments to 2025 long bill. (1) To implement this act, appropriations made in the annual general appropriation act for the 2025-26 state fiscal year to the department of corrections are adjusted as follows: (a) The general fund appropriation for use by the executive director's office for payments to in-state private prisons is decreased by \$946,497; and
(b) The general fund appropriation for use by community services for operating expenses related to the parole subprogram is decreased by \$31,017.
(2) For the 2025-26 state fiscal year, \$886,023 is appropriated to the community-based reentry services cash fund created in section 17-33-101 (7)(f.5)(I), C.R.S This appropriation is from the general fund. The department of corrections is responsible for the accounting related to this appropriation. (3) For the 2025-26 state fiscal year, \$75,448 is appropriated to

the judicial department for use by probation and related services division.

This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption

- 1 that the division will require an additional 0.8 FTE. To implement this
- 2 act, the division may use this appropriation for probation programs.".
- 3 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
- 4 Page 1 of the bill, line 101, strike "BEDS." and substitute "BEDS, AND, IN
- 5 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AND REDUCING AN
- 6 APPROPRIATION.".
