Within three days after receiving a report from the director, the state treasurer shall transfer the amount of money described in the report from the fund designated in the report. The director of the division may make multiple reports to the treasurer pursuant to this subsection (5)(c)(I).
 - (II) (A) IN ORDER TO RESTORE TO THE PARKS AND OUTDOOR RECREATION CASH FUND AND THE WILDLIFE CASH FUND THE AMOUNT OF MONEY TRANSFERRED FROM EACH FUND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (5)(c)(I) OF THIS SECTION, THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION MAY REPORT TO THE STATE TREASURER AN AMOUNT OF MONEY TO TRANSFER FROM THE FIREARMS TRAINING AND SAFETY COURSE CASH FUND TO THE PARKS AND OUTDOOR RECREATION CASH FUND OR TO THE WILDLIFE CASH FUND. WITHIN THREE DAYS AFTER RECEIVING A REPORT FROM THE DIRECTOR, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER THE AMOUNT OF MONEY DESCRIBED IN THE REPORT TO THE FUND DESIGNATED IN THE REPORT. THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION MAY MAKE MULTIPLE REPORTS TO THE TREASURER PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (5)(c)(II)(A).
 - (B) The total amount of the transfers to the parks and outdoor recreation cash fund and to the wildlife cash fund pursuant to this subsection (5)(c)(II) must not be greater than the total amount transferred from the relevant cash fund pursuant to subsection (5)(c)(I) of this section.
 - (C) By June 30, 2030, the total amount of the transfers to

THE PARKS AND OUTDOOR RECREATION CASH FUND REPORTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION TO THE STATE TREASURER PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (5)(c)(II) MUST BE EQUAL TO THE TOTAL AMOUNT TRANSFERRED FROM THE PARKS AND OUTDOOR RECREATION CASH FUND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (5)(c)(I) OF THIS SECTION.

(D) By June 30, 2030, the total amount of the transfers to THE WILDLIFE CASH FUND REPORTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION TO THE STATE TREASURER PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (5)(c)(II) MUST BE EQUAL TO THE TOTAL AMOUNT TRANSFERRED FROM THE WILDLIFE CASH FUND PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (5)(c)(I) OF THIS SECTION.

11 (III) THIS SUBSECTION (5)(c) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 12 2030.".

SECTION 7. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-35-122 as 14 15 follows:

24-35-122. Specified semiautomatic firearms guidance. THE 16 DIVISION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE RESPONSIBLE FOR ISSUING STATE FIREARMS DEALER PERMITS SHALL PROVIDE GUIDANCE AND CLARIFICATION TO ASSIST IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SECTION 18-12-116. 20 THE DIVISION SHALL PUBLISH AND MAKE PUBLICLY AVAILABLE GUIDANCE ABOUT SPECIFIC MODELS OF FIREARMS TO WHICH SECTION 18-12-116 (2) 22 APPLIES. THE DIVISION MAY CONSULT WITH FIREARM EXPERTS AND CONVENE WORKING GROUPS TO ASSIST WITH CREATING GUIDANCE ABOUT THE SPECIFIC MODELS OF FIREARMS TO WHICH SECTION 18-12-116 (2) APPLIES.".
