<u>HB21-1011</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on <u>Appropriations</u> with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 6, line 8, strike "IN WHICH THE".
- 2 Strike line 9 and substitute "IN THE STATE THAT HAS AT LEAST TWO
- 3 THOUSAND CITIZENS AGE EIGHTEEN YEARS OR OLDER WHO SPEAK ENGLISH
- 4 LESS THAN VERY WELL, AS DEFINED BY THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF
- 5 THE CENSUS AMERICAN COMMUNITY SURVEY OR COMPARABLE CENSUS
- 6 DATA, AND WHO SPEAK A SHARED MINORITY LANGUAGE AT HOME, AND IN
- 7 ANY ADDITIONAL LANGUAGES THE SECRETARY DETERMINES BY RULE IS
- 8 NEEDED TO ASSIST ELECTORS IN".
- 9 Page 6, line 17, strike "ACCESSIBLE" and substitute "AVAILABLE".
- Page 6, strike lines 21 through 24 and substitute "MUST BE AVAILABLE
- 11 ANYTIME A VOTER VISITS A VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTER DURING
- 12 THAT CENTER'S HOURS OF PUBLIC OPERATION. THE MULTILINGUAL BALLOT
- 13 HOTLINE MUST BE AVAILABLE TO ALL OTHER VOTERS BETWEEN 8 A.M. AND
- 14 5 P.M. MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY BEGINNING THE FIRST DAY THAT
- 15 DOMESTIC BALLOTS FOR STATEWIDE GENERAL AND COORDINATED
- 16 ELECTIONS ARE MAILED TO ELECTORS THROUGH THE FRIDAY BEFORE
- 17 ELECTION DAY. THE HOTLINE MUST BE AVAILABLE TO ALL VOTERS
- 18 BETWEEN 7 A.M. AND 7 P.M. ON THE MONDAY BEFORE ELECTION DAY AND
- 19 ON ELECTION DAY.".
- 20 Page 8, line 24, after "(3)" insert "LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STAFF SHALL



- 1 PROVIDE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE A TRANSLATION OF ALL STATEWIDE
- 2 BALLOT QUESTIONS OR ISSUES THAT WILL APPEAR ON THE BALLOT IN
- 3 EVERY LANGUAGE IN WHICH A MINORITY LANGUAGE SAMPLE BALLOT
- 4 MUST BE PROVIDED IN THE STATE.".
- 5 Page 11, line 15, strike "AN ELECTRONIC" and substitute "A".

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
