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SB 25B-005: REALLOCATE DNR WOLF FUNDING TO HEALTH INS ENTERTERPRISE

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Fiscal note status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as amended by the Senate State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee.

Summary Information

Overview. The bill reduces appropriations to the Department of Natural Resources for gray wolf reintroduction and transfers that amount to the Health Insurance Affordability Cash Fund.

Types of impacts. The bill is projected to affect the following areas in FY 2025-26:

- State Expenditures
- State Transfers

Appropriations. For the current FY 2025-26, the bill includes a reduction in appropriations to the Department of Natural Resources of \$264,268.

Summary of Legislation

In the current FY 2025-26, the bill reduces General Fund appropriations to Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) in the Department of Natural Resources by \$264,268, and transfers that amount to the Health Insurance Affordability Cash Fund in the Division of Insurance in the Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA).

State Transfers

On September 1, 2025, the bill transfers \$264,268 from the General Fund to the Health Insurance Affordability Cash Fund.

State Expenditures

In FY 2025-26, the bill reduces General Fund expenditures in the CPW by \$264,268 for expenses related to acquiring additional grey wolves. The fiscal note assumes the Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise in DORA will use this money in FY 2026-27 to support the various programs operated by the enterprise. The Health Insurance Affordability Cash Fund is continuously appropriated to DORA, so the exact timing of when this money will be spent may differ from this fiscal note estimate.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
