Committee on Transportation, Housing & Local Government.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB25-187 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 3, strike "(35)(a)(VI)" and substitute
2 "(31)(a)(XIV)".

3 Page 2, strike lines 10 through 13 and substitute:

4 "(31)(a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled
5 for repeal on September 1, 2030:

6 (XIV) THE MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR SAFETY TRAINING PROGRAM
7 CREATED IN PART 5 OF ARTICLE 5 OF TITLE 43."

8 Page 3, line 1, strike "SEPTEMBER 1, 2034." and substitute "SEPTEMBER
9 1, 2030."

10 Page 3, strike lines 8 through 14.

11 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

12 Page 3, after line 21 insert:

13 "SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-5-504, **add** (4)
14 as follows:

15 **43-5-504. Motorcycle operator safety training fund - tuition**
16 **benefit - definitions.** (4) (a) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS
17 SECTION TO THE CONTRARY, THE CHIEF MAY EXPEND MONEY FROM THE
18 FUND FOR A TUITION BENEFIT PAID TO MOST VENDORS TO BE PASSED ON
19 TO ELIGIBLE STUDENTS IN THE FORM OF REDUCED COSTS FOR ELIGIBLE
20 COURSES AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4).

21 (b) TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A TUITION BENEFIT TO PASS ON TO

1 ELIGIBLE STUDENTS, A MOST VENDOR SHALL PROVIDE A RECEIPT
2 ESTABLISHING THAT THE TUITION BENEFIT WAS PASSED ON TO AN ELIGIBLE
3 STUDENT WHO FULLY COMPLETED THE TRAINING AND ANY OTHER
4 DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED BY THE CHIEF AS ESTABLISHED BY RULE.
5 (c) THE CHIEF SHALL DETERMINE THE ALLOCATION FOR A MOST
6 VENDOR FOR THE TUITION BENEFIT ALLOWED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4)
7 BASED ON THE FOLLOWING FACTORS, OR AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY
8 RULE:
9 (I) THE AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE FUND;
10 (II) FOR A MOST VENDOR THAT HAS BEEN CERTIFIED FOR OVER
11 TWO YEARS, THE HISTORICAL DATA FOR ELIGIBLE STUDENTS AND ELIGIBLE
12 COURSES OVER THE PREVIOUS TWO YEARS; OR
13 (III) FOR A MOST VENDOR THAT HAS BEEN CERTIFIED FOR TWO
14 YEARS OR LESS, THE AVAILABLE HISTORICAL DATA FOR ELIGIBLE
15 STUDENTS AND ELIGIBLE COURSES OR AN ESTIMATE OF THE ELIGIBLE
16 STUDENTS AND ELIGIBLE COURSES.
17 (d) AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION (4), UNLESS THE CONTEXT
18 OTHERWISE REQUIRES:
19 (I) "ELIGIBLE COURSE" MEANS A CERTIFIED MOTORCYCLE
20 OPERATOR SAFETY TRAINING COURSE THAT MEETS ALL REQUIREMENTS
21 ESTABLISHED BY RULE.
22 (II) "ELIGIBLE STUDENT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ELIGIBLE
23 TO ENROLL IN AN ELIGIBLE COURSE AND WHO MEETS ALL OTHER
24 REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY RULE.
25 (e) THE CHIEF MAY ADOPT RULES AS NECESSARY FOR THE
26 IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SUBSECTION (4).".
